

St. Augustine, FL – The public is invited to attend a two part workshop at St. Photios Greek Orthodox National Shrine called <u>Healing Oils of the Bible</u>. "Along the bank of the river, on this side and that, will grow all kinds of trees used for food. Their leaves will not wither, and their fruit will not fail. They will bear fruit every month, because their waters flow from the sanctuary. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for healing." Ezekiel 47:12

Workshop leader, Gina Maria, LMT, teaches participants about a commodity which was more precious than gold or silver, the healing oils of the ancient world. Twelve oils in all will be discussed.
